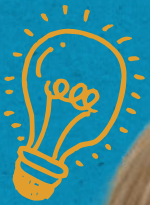

FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Friend,

This year marks the 13th year since the Menachem Education Foundation was established. Our Bar Mitzvah year is the perfect opportunity to reflect on all that we have accomplished but also to remind ourselves of all that is yet to come. In the world of Chinuch, we are always thinking of long-term goals and our decisions and investments must always be based on big-picture objectives of where we want to go, not just a few months or years from now, but for generations.

When Rabbi Osher Farkash set out to become a Mechanech, he turned to his Mashpia and asked him "What advice can you give me?" His Mashpia replied, "When you look at an individual student don't get caught up in the minutia. Don't see this bochur as someone who came late to Chassidus and you need to start arguing with him about it. View this bochur as someone who is like an entire city or even a country and treat him with that long lens view that he contains multitudes."

In Chabad, it is true that many of our students who graduate from our yeshivas and seminaries do go on to have tremendous influence over big cities and even countries. It is a sacred responsibility that our Mechanchim have to educate the future movers and shakers of the world. And even for a child who will not be the Shliach of a big city, that student may be the one to do the Mitzvah that will bring Moshiach.

I recently heard a story from my friend Rabbi Eli Posner about his grandfather, Reb Zushe Posner, A"H. Before Reb Zushe passed away, a former student came to visit him and asked, "Do you recognize me?" Reb Zushe, who at this point had a hard time speaking, motioned to his ears as if to ask the man if he used to have long Payos as a child. The man confirmed that he did, and Reb Zushe smiled and said, "Yes, I remember you." The man had come from a non-Lubavitch family, yet as a bochur, he wanted to go to a Chabad yeshiva. But his learning skills were not up to par and the Hanhola did not want to accept him. Reb Zushe, who was then a young bochur, turned to the Hanhola and said "I was sent by the Rebbe to teach. The Rebbe did not specify that only smart kids or only Lubavitch kids should learn. I am here to teach everybody." The Hanhola relented and accepted the boy. 65 years later the man, who now has a Chasidische family of children and grandchildren, sought out Reb Zushe before he passed away to say thank you. A new generation of Chabad Chasidim was created thanks to one bochur's determination to teach.

This year, MEF started a series of interviews highlighting Mechanchim in Chabad Moisdos. One that stood out to me was Rabbi Eily Smith who describes the experience of accepting bochrin to Yeshiva whom others did not want to take, and finding that these students succeeding was the greatest nachas of all.

In Chinuch, no child can be left behind.

This is our moment in Chinuch to think long-term, think big, and include every single child in that vision. When we think broadly, that is when we will see the greatest Hatzlacha.

I want to thank the incredible big thinkers on the MEF team who work hard every day to make our organization successful. Thank you to **Mrs. Chanah Rose**, our Educational Director, **Mrs. Sarah Pinson**, our Communications Director, **Mrs. Ety Teleshevsky**, our Office Administrator, **Rabbi Chaim Kaminker**, who took on the new role of Associate Director of Our Heritage, and welcome to **Ms. Sarah Varon**, who manages various MEF projects. I would like to give a special thank you to **Mrs. Henny Bartfield**, whose tremendous dedication and devotion to our SEL project has produced extraordinary results.

Thank you to our generous donors who make our work possible, especially the leading benefactor of MEF, **Mr. Alan Zekelman** for your steadfast devotion and support of Torah learning and your investment in improving Chinuch and spreading Yiddishkeit.

This organization has been the collaborative effort of hundreds of Mechanchim over the years who have given of themselves to advancing the Shlichus of Chinuch. Thank you.

And of course, my heartfelt gratitude to Hashem for allowing me to do this holy work, and for the many Brachos our organization has received over the years to grow from strength to strength and be a part of the bigger picture for a strong Chabad Chinuch for years to come.

IN REVIEW

> Training Teachers

Provided individual mentorship to dozens of educators, in depth consultation to **11** schools, and professional development workshops and webinars to at least **10** schools in five time zones.

> Empowering School Leaders

Ran **3** in-person Chabad School Leadership Retreats with **65** principals in attendance.

> Providing a Jewish education

As of Year **3**, MEF's Our Heritage program has now enrolled **459** public students in **28** Jewish day schools, and opened up to international schools as well in honor of Hakhel. Our Heritage school principals also engaged in intensive consultation with marketing expert Gary Wexler over a six month period.

> Building Social-Emotional Health

The "Heart of Chinuch" social-emotional learning curriculum was rebranded as "Project Tomim," and piloted in **11** schools and **25** classrooms. The curriculum was revised, expanded, printed and delivered to benefit **480** students.

> Raising Learning Standards

Rebranding and refreshing materials and resources deferred to next year, online users of the standards and resources grew to **780**, and we delivered In-depth consultation to **3** schools internationally, including Yiddish speaking schools.

> Reaching the Whole Child

The "Teach and Reach" program finished the year with **30** Mechanchos on board, and the new program for Mechanchim, Menahalim and Mashpiim - "Lehagia Ulehashpia" - trained **44** to guide their Bochorim with skill and sensitivity.

> Chabad Chinuch Convention

600 Mechanchos attended in-person and **152** online at the **7th** Annual Kinus Mechanchos Chabad, making it the largest Chabad Chinuch Convention yet

> Mechanchos Farbrengens

A second year of monthly online farbrengens completed, and new monthly learning for Shnas Hakhel, called "ללמוד וללמד" - Learning in Order to Teach" - launched with Rabbi Z. L. Markowitz.

> Mental Health Awareness

A total of **174** educators trained in Mental Health First Aid, and a Crisis Protocol for Chabad Schools was created and published, with a full day training for principals.

> Growing our Impact

MEF expanded our team with additional talent, enabling greater impact, including project management, curriculum production, and development. Chinuch job placement service directly placed **13** principals and teachers throughout the U.S. and indirectly serviced many more in their job search. **200** Mechanchos joined a chavrusa program to learn Klalei HaChinuch V'haHadracha, and more!

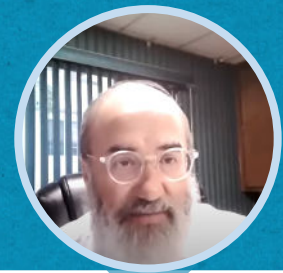

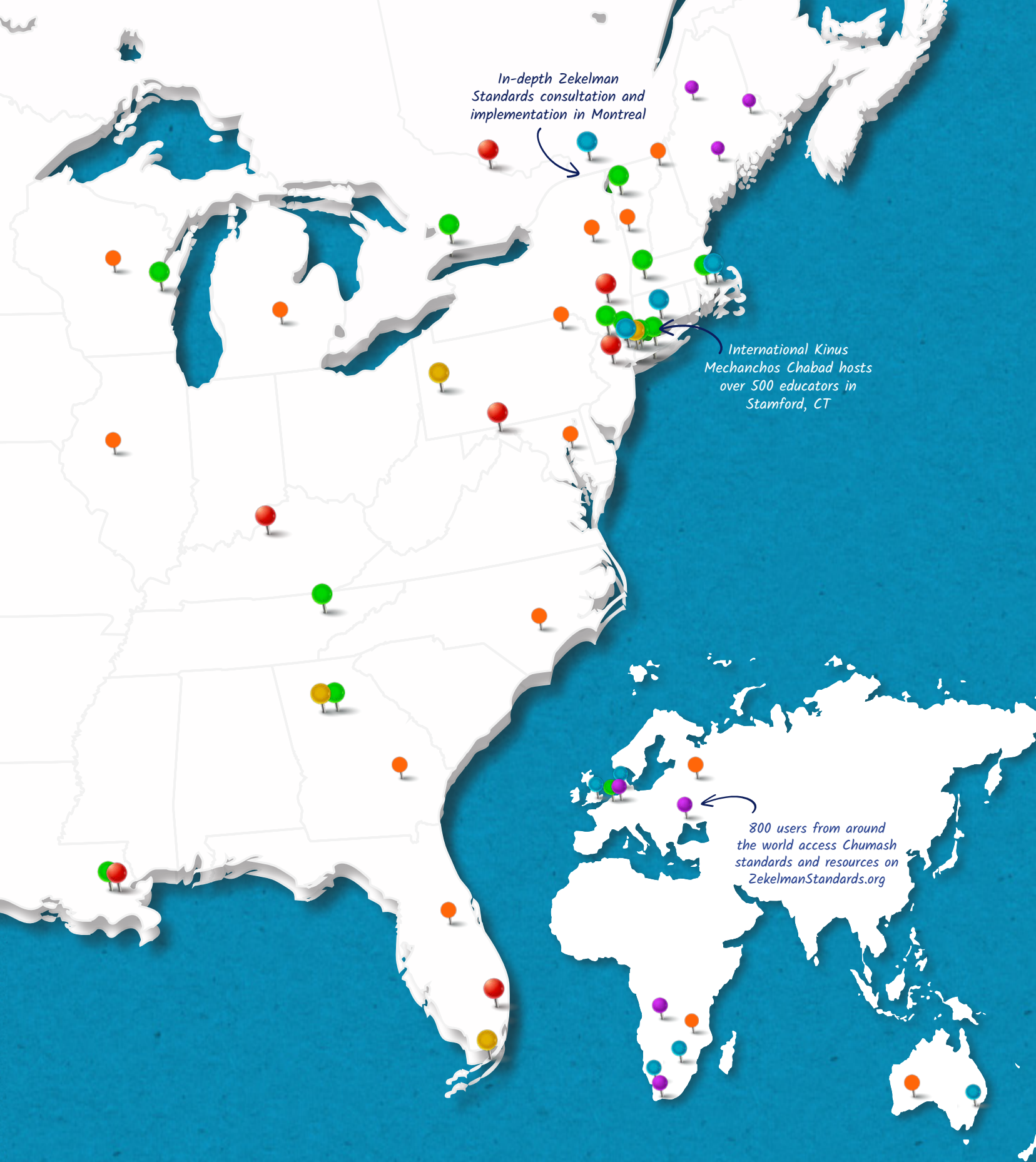

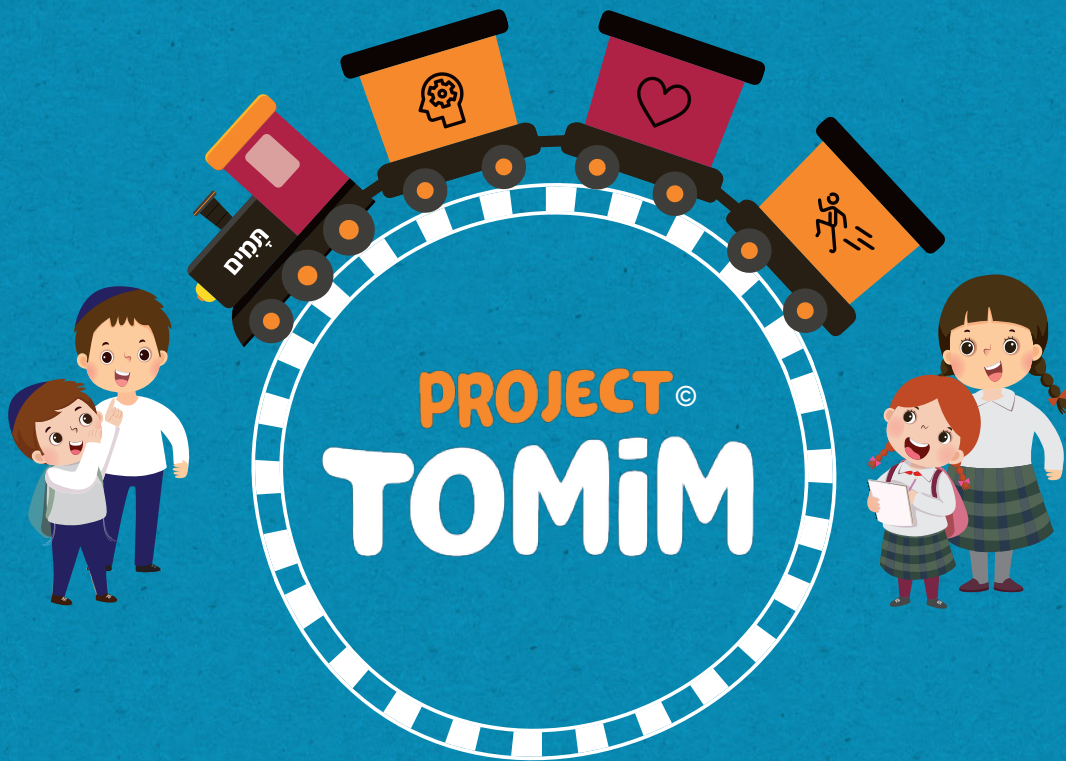

Tomim Equals Optimism

SLIDE 23

This is how it works:

- » Something happens - we hear or see something and that starts the train ride.
- » We think about the experience.
- » Our thoughts about the experience then create a feeling.
- » And then we react.
 - *The thought is what leads the other cars of the train in the same direction.*
 - *If we have a positive thought, we will have a positive feeling.*
 - *Then we will choose a positive action.*
 - *Our train will lead us to a state of wellbeing - a place where we are in a happy mood; where we feel safe, happy, and secure.*



Ask the students: If that is how the train reaction works for a positive thought, does that mean the opposite happens with a negative thought?

The teacher allows students to discuss this idea.

SLIDE 24

It seems like the train is indeed heading in the opposite direction from wellbeing.

It seems

- *that an unpleasant thought*
- *leads to unpleasant feelings*
- *which leads to unpleasant actions.*

Our train reaction takes us to a place where we are in a bad mood; where we feel unsafe, unhappy, and insecure.

In that case, the engine of our train reaction will be heading away from wellbeing.








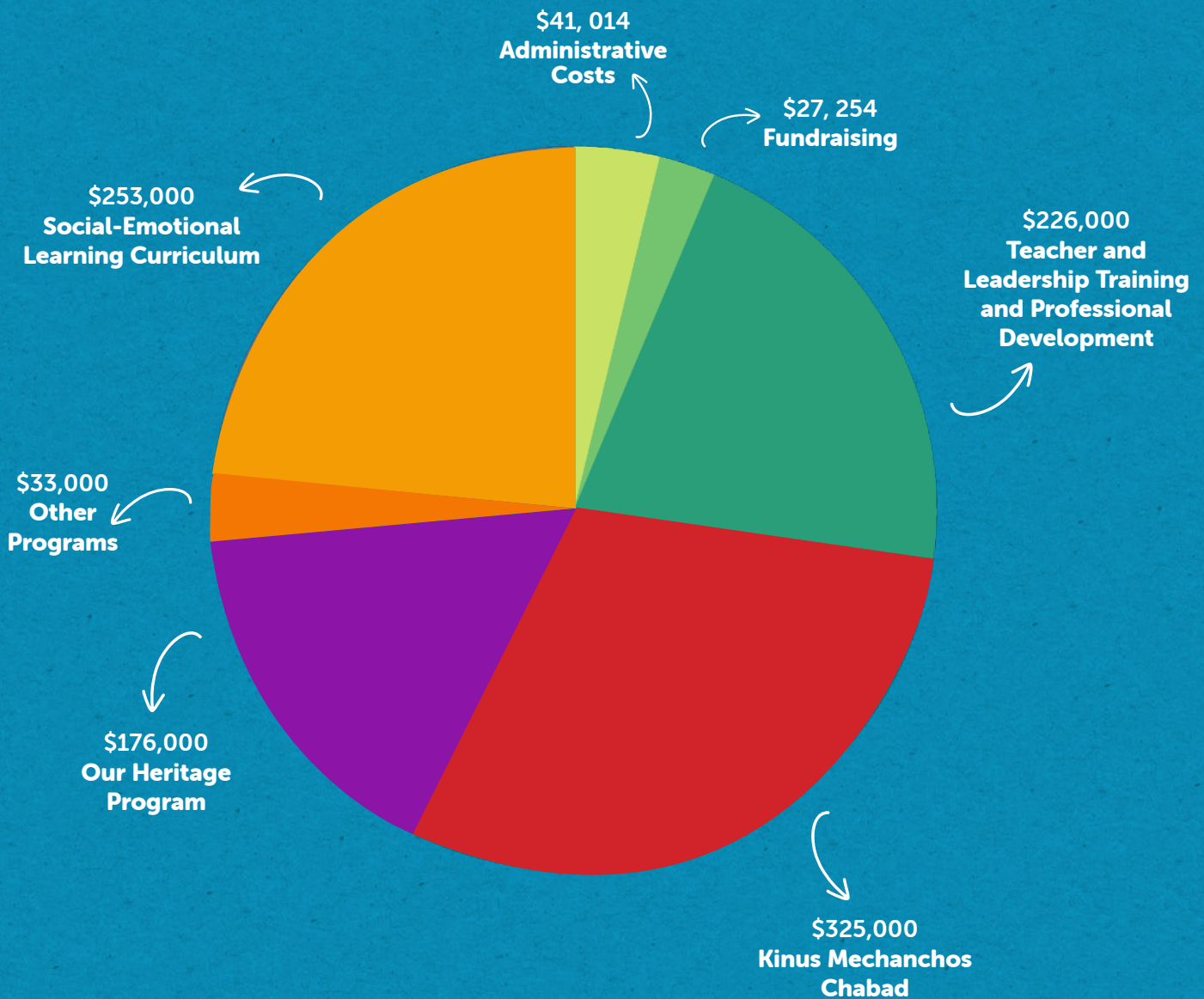
